SC 61C interpretation sheet on: Subclause 30.2.101 with respect to testing of built-in appliances and interpretation of accessible non-metallic material

Questions: Some questions have arisen over the text added to 30.2 and 30.2.101 via AMD2 concerning non-metallic material on the external rear surfaces of an appliance that is in direct contact with thermal insulation. These are:

- a) Is the non-metallic material on the external rear surfaces of an appliance that is in direct contact with thermal insulation considered to be "accessible non-metallic material"?
- b) Does the term "accessible" have the meaning defined in 3.6.3 of Part 1?
- c) What force is applied to test probe B when judging accessibility?
- d) For built-in appliances, is accessibility judged before the appliance is built-in?
